**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 033, Series of 2013**

**REORGANIZING THE CITY PEACE AND ORDER COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, Section 116 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides for the organization of the Local Peace and Order Councils, pursuant to Executive No. 309, as amended, Series of 1998.

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 773 dated January 5, 2009 issued by HER EXCELLENCY PRESIDENT GLORIA MACAPAGAL-ARROYO further reorganized the Peace and Order Councils on the national, regional, provincial, city and municipal levels of government;

WHEREAS, Section (1), (d) of Executive Order No. 773 enumerates further the composition of the City Peace and Order Council;

WHEREAS, the City Peace and Order Council would serve as an advisory body on peace and order and public safety matters;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ARTHUR F CELESTE, of the City Mayor of Alaminos, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby reorganize the City Peace and Order Council of this City, as follows:

*Section 1. COMPOSITION:* The composition of the City Peace and Order Council (CPOC) shall be reorganized and composed of the following:

*Section 2. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS:* The City Peace and Order Council shall perform the following functions:

1. Provide a forum for dialogue and deliberations of major issues and problems affecting peace and order, including insurgency;
2. Recommend measures which will improve or enhance peace and order and public safety in their respective areas of responsibility, including anti-insurgency measures;
3. Recommend measures to converge and/or orchestrate internal security operation efforts of civil authorities and agencies, military and police;
4. Apply moral suasion to and/or recommend sanctions against city and/or barangay executives who are giving material and political support to the communist rebels;
5. Monitor the provision of livelihood and infrastructure development programs and projects in the remote rural and indigenous population areas adopted to isolate them

from the communist rebels' "Agitate/Arouse; Organize and Mobilize" and ideological, political and organizational works;

6. Perform all other functions assigned by law, the President or the National Peace and Order Council (NPOC)

The Civilian Volunteer Organizations (CVOs) shall be managed and supervised by the city chief of police.

*Section 3. CITY PEACE AND ORDER COUNCIL SECRETARIAT-* There shall be a City Peace and Order Council Secretariat which shall handle the administrative and technical activities of the City Peace and Order Council (CPOC). The Secretariat shall also undertake liasoning and coordination of activities with appropriate agencies of the government.

The City Local Government Operations Officer (CLGOO) shall act as the Secretary of the CPOC and shall be assisted in its functions and duties by the regular staff of the CPOC Chairman.

*Section 4. REPEALING CLAUSE-* All prior issuances on the organization and functions of the City Peace and Order Council inconsistent herewith shall be deemed superseded by this order.

*Section 5. EFFECTIVITY-* This order shall take effect immediately.
