EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 007

"REORGANIZING AND STRENGTHENING THE CITY COOPERATIVE DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (CCDC) IN ALAMINOS CITY, PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA), the lead agency in cooperative promotion, development and regulation per executive Order No. 95, dated June 8, 1993, recognizes the indispensability of the Cooperative Development Councils (CDC) as the mechanism to ensure a strong partnership between and among the CDA, other National Government Agencies (NGAs), including the Government Financial Institutions and Instrumentalities (GFIs), the Local Government Units (LGUs), Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) and the Cooperative Movement itself for the purpose of advancing the spirit of cooperativism in the Philippines.

WHEREAS, the CDA has promulgated new guidelines in the organization and operation of Cooperative Development Council in the City as per CDA Memorandum Circular No. 2011-02;

WHEREAS, there is a need to re-organize the City Cooperative Development Council in the City of Alaminos for the purpose of strengthening cooperative developments through collaboration, consultation and coordination of the various cooperative programs and projects of the government agencies in partnership with the cooperative sector;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ARTHUR F. CELESTE in consideration of the foregoing premises and by virtue of the power vested in me by law as the City Mayor of Alaminos City, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. Re-organizing and strengthening of the **CITY COOPERATIVE DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL** in Alaminos City, as a result of the election of officers held last November 15, 2013 at the City Hall Bldg. Alaminos City, Pangasinan which is composed of the following:

All agencies with connection to different accredited Alaminos City cooperatives are members of the said council.

SECTION 2. Mandate. It shall be the primary mandate of the Council to serve as a mechanism for collaboration, consultation and coordination in the implementation of various programs and projects implemented by all government branches, instrumentalities, subdivisions, and agencies for the cooperatives.

SECTION 3. Powers and Functions. The Council shall have the following powers and functions:

- To coordinate, harmonize and monitor the implementation of various cooperative development plans, programs and projects of NGAs, GFIs, NGOs, LGUs and Councils concerned;
- To operationalize and monitor the Cooperative Medium Term Development Plans (CMTDP) through the collective efforts of all sectors and to develop such mechanism as may be required in line with the CMTDP;
- To share resources (financial, supplies and equipment ,manpower) towards the full realization of such development plans;
- To support, assist, and participate in the holding of cooperative activities such as but not limited to the celebrations of cooperative month, scheduled cooperative congress and summits; and
- To promote actively and strongly endorse the observance at all times of the universal cooperative principles and enshrined in the Cooperative Code in the performance of the above functions.

SECTION 4. Secretariat. The City Cooperatives Office, the agency in charge of the Livelihood Development Program of the City government, shall serve as the Secretariat of the City Cooperative Development Council.

The council is hereby authorized to convene immediately to discuss their plan of action to strengthen cooperative developments.

This order takes effect immediately.
