



**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 014**

**CREATING THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT (LGU) PERFORMANCE CHALLENGE FUND (PCF) PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION UNIT/TEAM**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Local Government Code of 1991 or Republic Act 7160, Local Government Units are mandated to assume the primary responsibility of providing basic services and facilities to improve the quality of life of their constituents through programs and projects geared towards the achievement of MDGs; preparedness to disasters and adaptation to climate change; sustainable environmental management; and transparent and accountable local governance;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) through the Bureau of Local Government Development (BLGD) is the office with primary responsibility in localizing the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs), and through the Regional Office in capacitating LGUs to effectively discharge their powers and functions towards improving the delivery of basic services and facilities to their constituents;

**WHEREAS**, the Performance Challenge Fund (PCF) for Local Government Units is a flagship program of the DILG that serves as a facility that will help stimulate LGUs that will put premium on transparency and accountability to enable them to avail themselves of financial support to jumpstart and sustain social socio-economic development initiatives supportive of national government goals and priorities. It is an incentive fund to eligible LGUs to support in the implementation of high-impact capital investment projects consonant in the Annual Investment Program (AIP) of the LGU;

**WHEREAS**, the Performance Challenge Fund is the progressive realization to achieve the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs), maintenance of core road network to boost tourism and local economic development; comply with the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) and Management Act of 2010 and Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000; and promote transparency and accountability; programs and projects are anchored on the contribution of local government units (LGUs), as well as non-government and private sector organization;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, ARTHUR F. CELESTE, Mayor of the City of Alaminos, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law do here order:

**Section 1. Creation and Composition of the Project Implementation Team.** The Project Implementation Team of the LGU-PCF is hereby created and composed of:

**Section 2. Functions, Duties and Responsibilities.** The Project Implementation Team shall perform the following functions, duties and responsibilities:

- 2.1. Prepare the project action plan and budget and submit the same for the approval to the Office of the Mayor;
- 2.2. Ensure that the implementation of the project is free from all liens, encumbrances and other legal problems;
- 2.3. Recommend measures for the development of the necessary components of the project not funded by the DILG, subject to the approval of the Office of the Mayor and pursuant to accounting and auditing rules and regulations;
- 2.4. Recommend to the Office of the Mayor the development plans and technical specifications and cost estimates to the DILG and secure related permits and clearances from concerned government agencies;
- 2.5. Provide post-infrastructure development activities such as reports and maintenance of the project to include cost-recovery activities;
- 2.6. Recommend to the Mayor to accept, maintain and repair completed infrastructure project;

**Section 3. Effectivity.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
