CELESTE, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY-REGION I (TESDA-I), REPRESENTED BY PROVINCIAL DIRECTOR, ENGR. MANUEL B. WONG, CESO IV, FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF VARIOUS PROJECTS TO BE FUNDED UNDER THE 2014 GRASSROOTS PARTICIPATORY BUDGETING PROCESS (GPBP)

WHEREAS, the Philippine Development Plan's Goal is to attain Inclusive Growth and Poverty Reduction and Promote Good Governance at the local levels;

WHEREAS, in pursuit to this goal, priority poverty reduction projects identified at the city level through a participatory planning and budgeting process shall be implemented;

WHEREAS, the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) is mandated to provide technical-vocational skills training programs to enhance the knowledge, skills and attitude of target beneficiaries towards wage-employment or entrepreneurial activities (self-employment);

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 allows the national agency to complement national funded projects, facilities, programs, and services jointly or with the assistance of the Local Government Units (LGUs);

WHEREAS, the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) issued to TESDA, funds under the General Appropriations Act FY 2014 which will be made available for expenditure in relation to the implementation of CY 2014 Grassroots Participatory Budgeting Projects of various Technical-Vocational Skills Training Programs;

WHEREAS, the following Livelihood Skills Training Projects as agreed upon by the Local Poverty Reduction Team and the Local Government Unit of Alaminos shall contribute in poverty reduction program of the local and national government:

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished to concern agencies for information and guidance. **UNANIMOUSLY ADOPTED.....**


